## Kitten Wellness Plan would include everything listed plus:

- 1 year total of flea/tick prevention \$216.00
- Microchip and Microchip Placement \$40.00
- Basic Feline Spay/Neuter \$245-\$345.00
- Full pre-anesthesia blood panel including intestinal parasite screening and FIV/FELV/Heartworm test \$90.00
- Pre-anesthesia medication for nausea/anxiety \$ 20.00
- Complimentary nail trims until pet is 12 months old - \$18 each
- 1 additional IPS (stool sample) if needed - \$25.50
- Complimentary comprehensive sick pet exams as needed until pet is 12 months old - \$55.00 each = \$550.00 possible
- 10% off of prescription medications until pet is 12 months old.

**The total value of this program is up to \$1250.00**

## Program Cost:

- Initial sign-up fee of \$75
- \$120 due at each visit for a total of 4 payments
- \* Total program cost of \$555.00

## Restrictions

- Pet must be signed up by 14 weeks of age.
- Can drop out of program at any time but there will be no refunds of money already paid.
- The program cannot be changed, altered, transferred to another pet or put on hold.
- The vaccines must be given 3-4 weeks apart.
- Umbilical hernias, undescended testicles, and other add on procedures at the time of the Spay/Neuter will be additional cost.
- The preventatives will be given out as single doses at each visit. Once plan is paid in full the remaining product will be given out.
